

Tallawarra Lands - EnergyAustralia (formerly TRUenergy) – A LandTeam survey project since 2005 and a project for which LandTeam was a finalist in the 2010 NSW Excellence in Surveying and Spatial Information Awards for the entry "Tallawarra Lands Spatial Information Project".

Adjoining Tallawarra Power Station, Tallawarra Lands is a proposed project to develop a mixed-zone area that will benefit the local community. The Tallawarra Lands project is a 536 hectare site which began in 2005 when TRUenergy first submitted a proposal to the Wollongong Council to rezone and to rejuvenate the area and create a sustainable plan for Tallawarra Lands.



The vision is to rejuvenate the Tallawarra Lands with a balanced mix of zones for employment, residential, recreational and conservation uses which will significantly benefit the local Illawarra community and provide employment and economic opportunities, new residential housing and over 200 hectares of protected environmental reserves.

The NSW Planning Commission has approved the Concept Plan for Tallawarra Lands- the development of the Concept Plan has been a complex process and involved many hours of stakeholder consultation. An evaluation of specific development options for the Tallawarra Lands site is necessary before development can proceed. Being a significant project this process is likely to take time.
