



# Binda Bridge Works

During the period from September 2013 through to July 2014, LandTeam survey staff have been heavily involved with the Roads and Maritime Services' project for the construction of a new concrete bridge over the Crookwell River on Main Road 54 near Binda in the NSW Southern Tablelands.

The new concrete bridge being constructed replaces the existing timber truss bridge that has been in use since its completion in 1903.

After originally being contracted to undertake set out, verification and conformance surveys relating to the earthworks and construction of the deviations to the existing road alignment at both approaches to the new bridge site, LandTeam's survey role was expanded to include similar works relating to the construction of the bridge itself from the early stages of construction.

Survey personnel have at times worked closely with RMS construction crews to set position and levels of various components of the bridge, to ensure correct alignment and design levels are achieved as the components are installed.

Strict quality management procedures and assessment of survey results have been a feature of the work undertaken on this project, which has been managed by ace surveyor Michael Kadziela in our Southern Tablelands Branch based in Goulburn.
